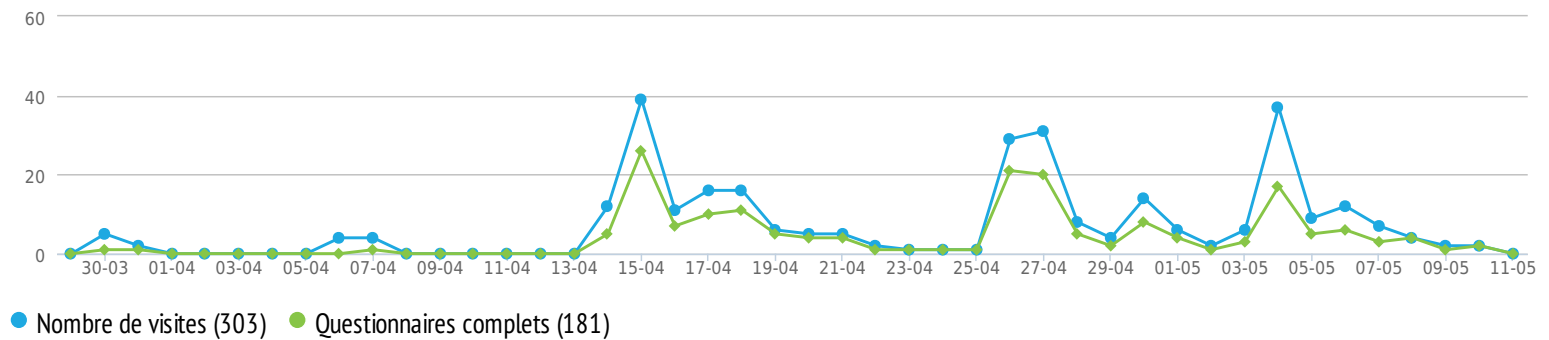

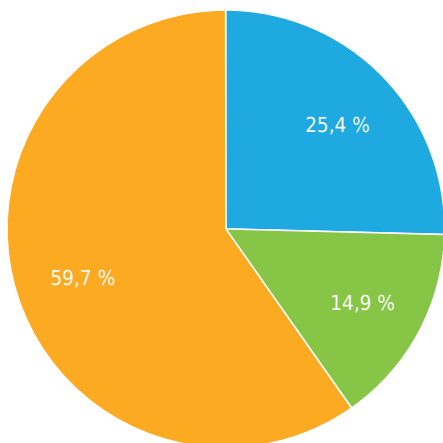

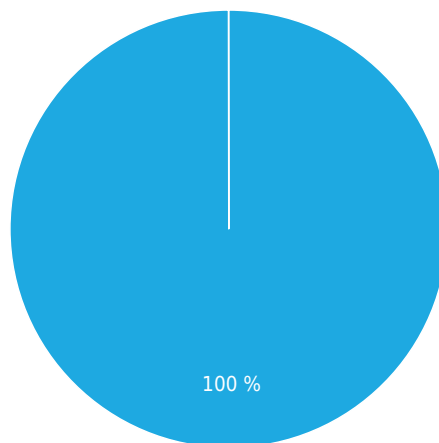

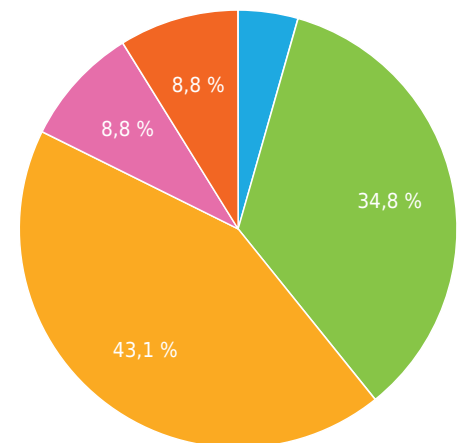

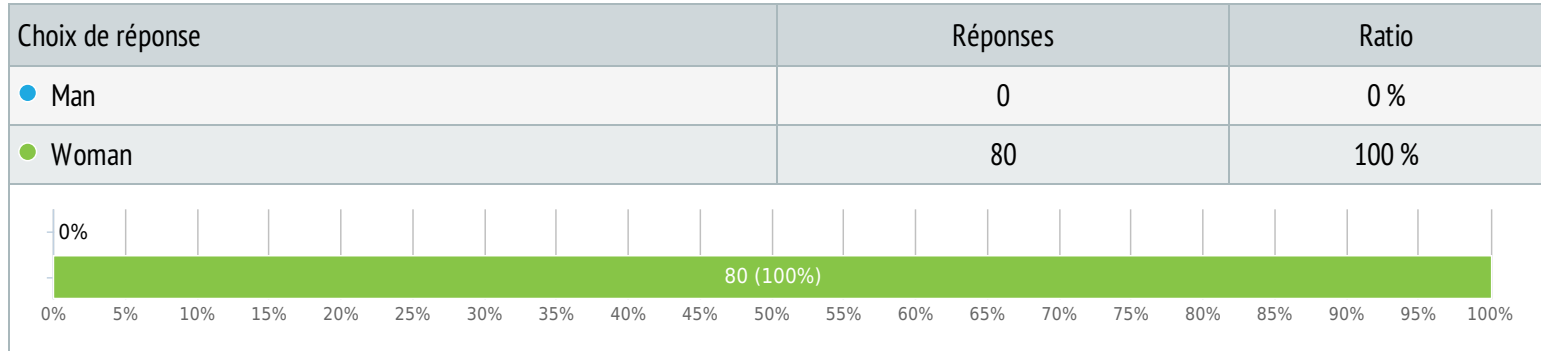

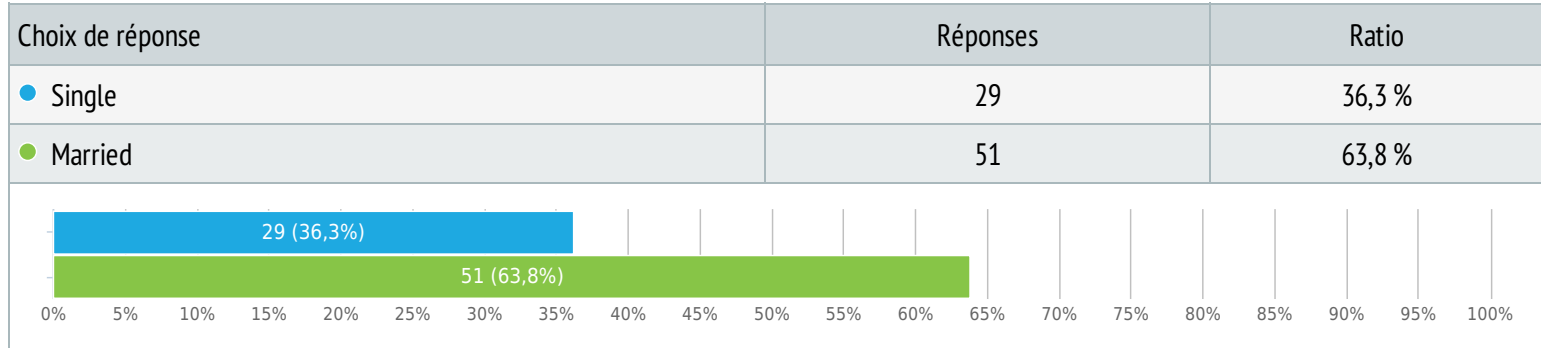
2. Age:

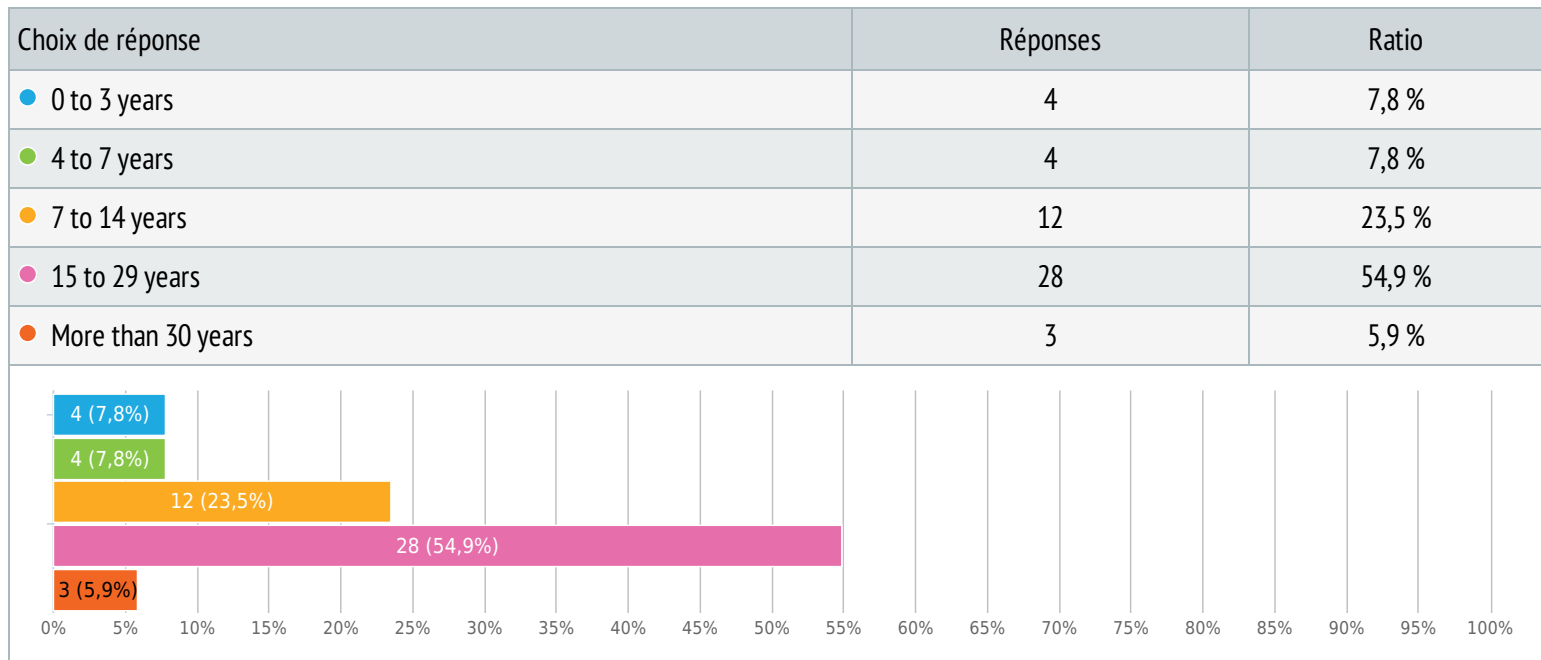

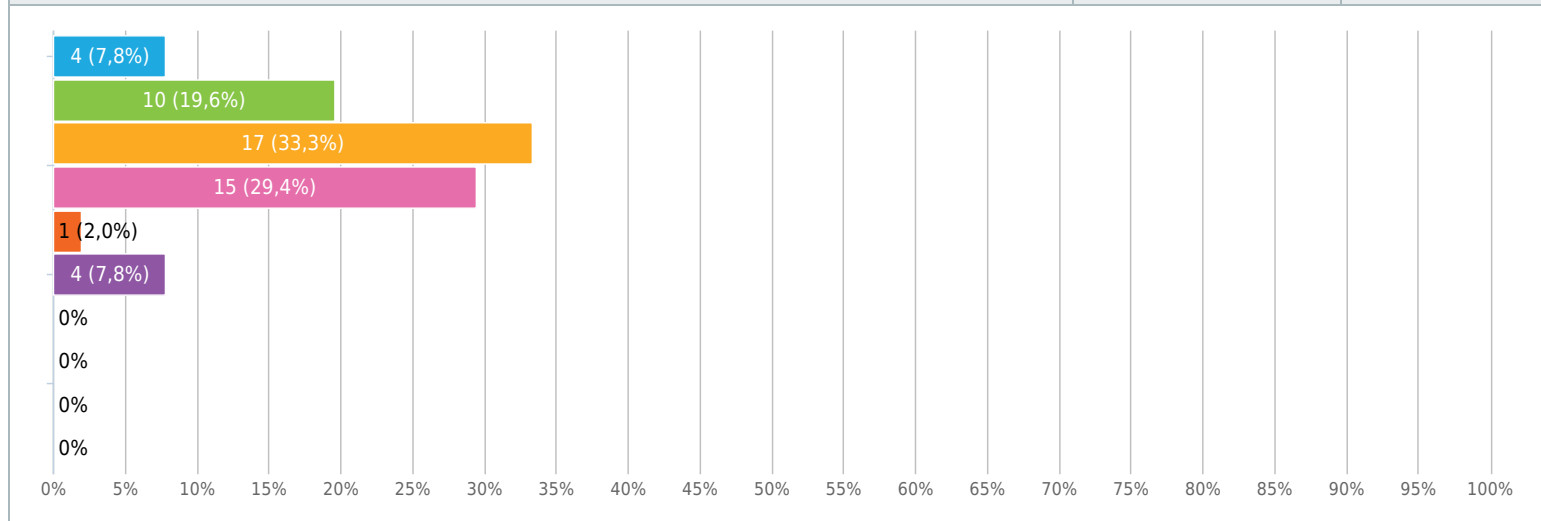

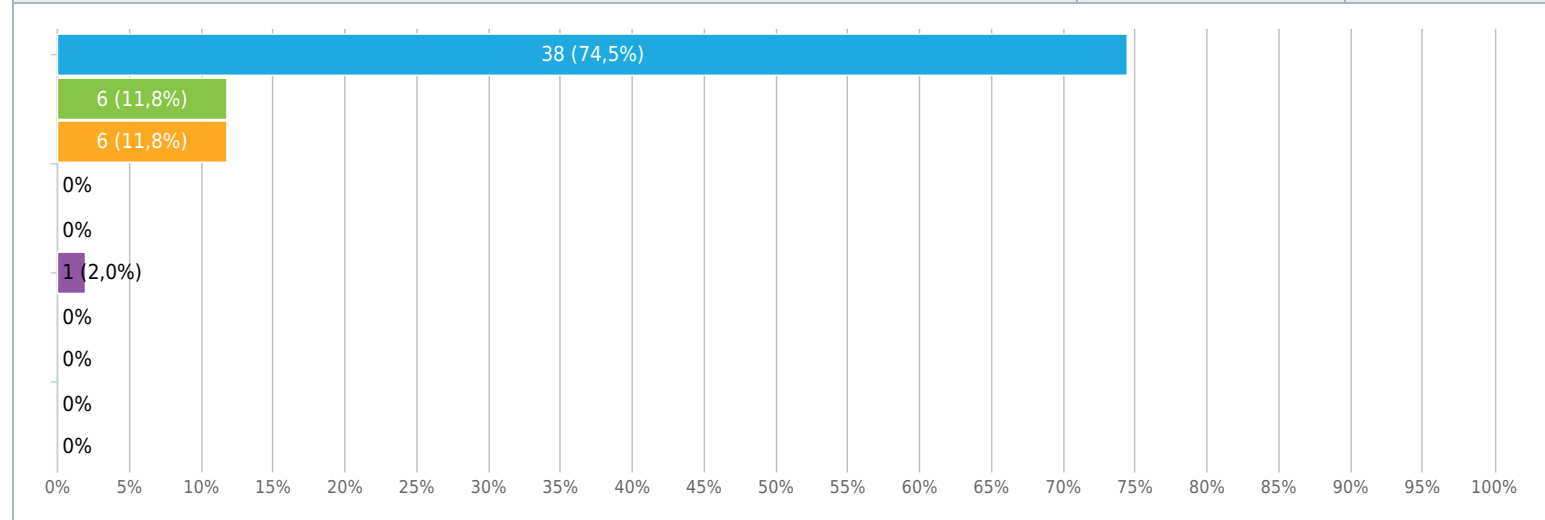

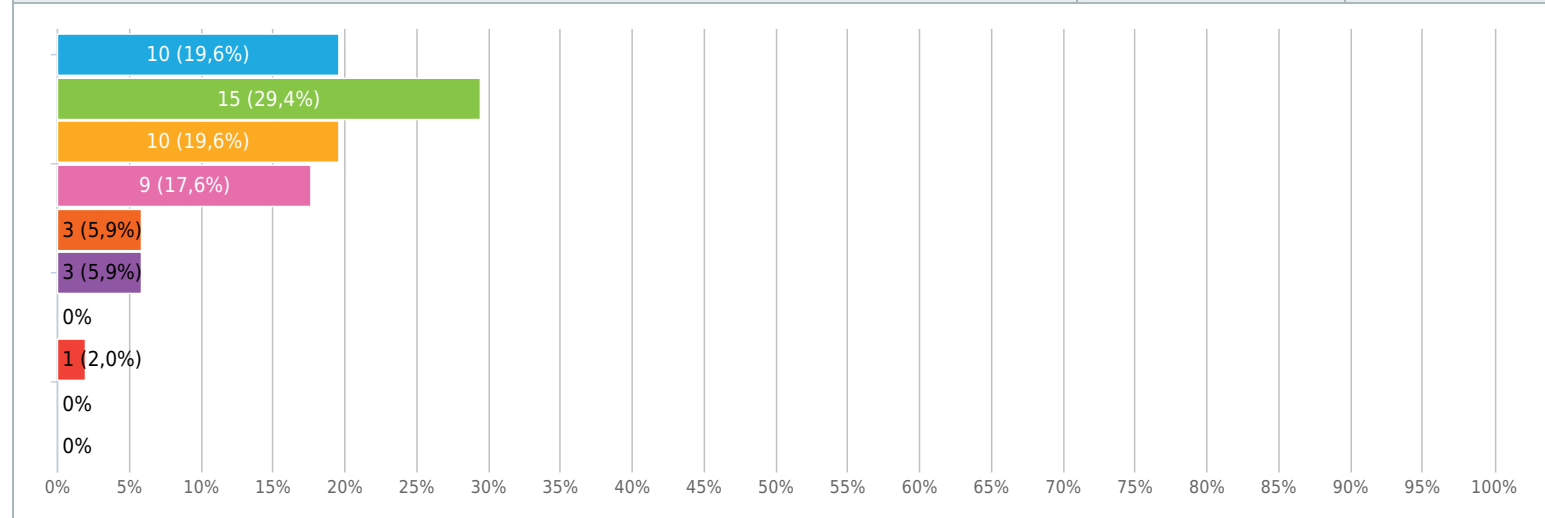

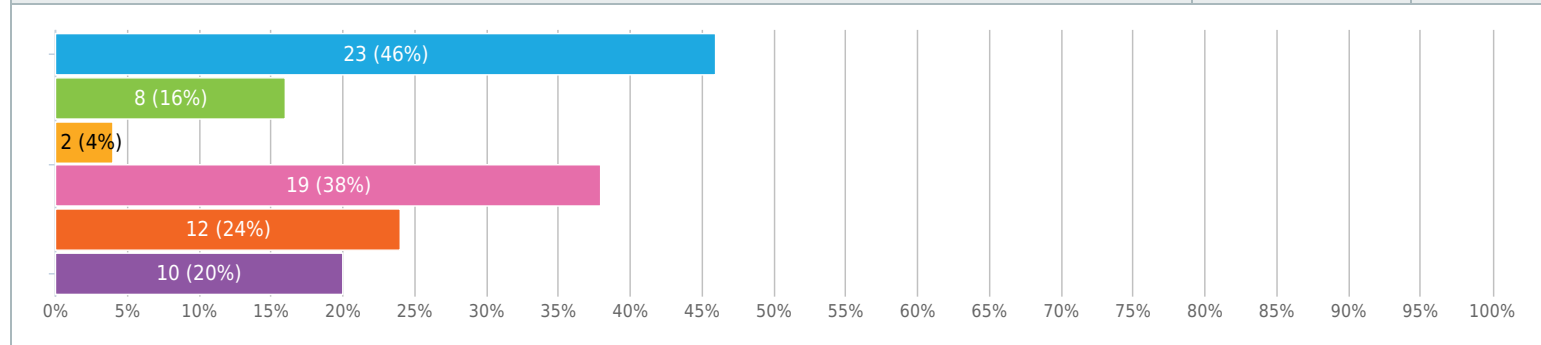

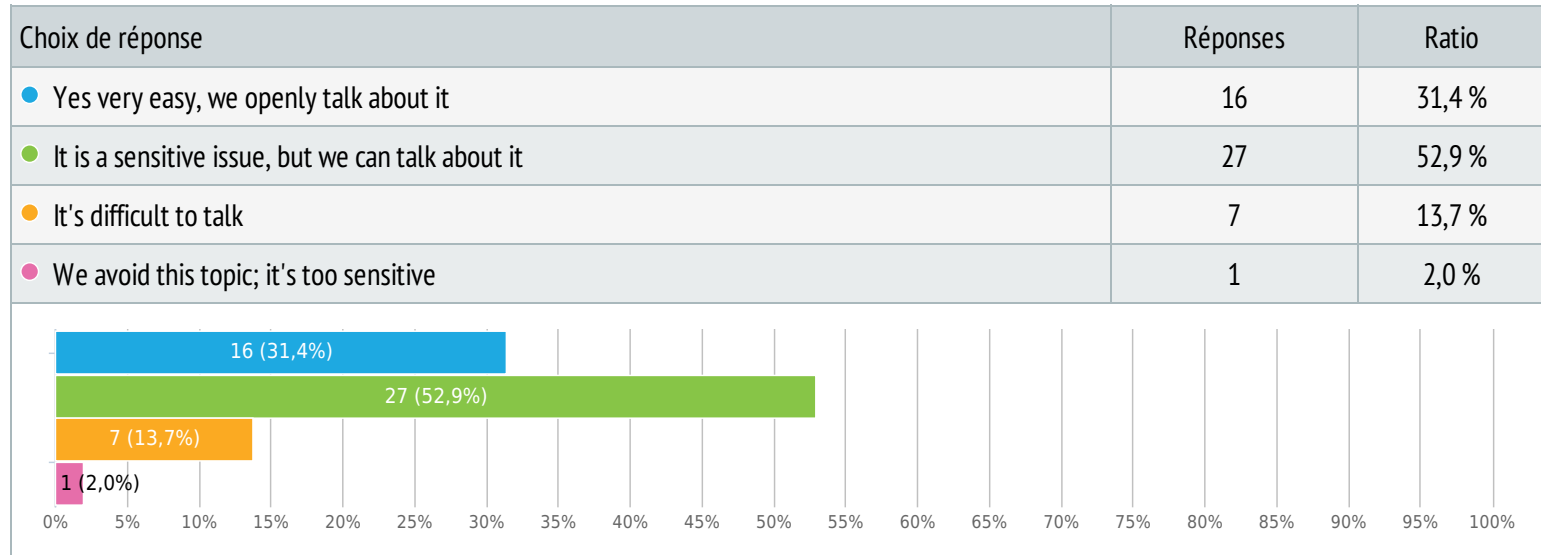

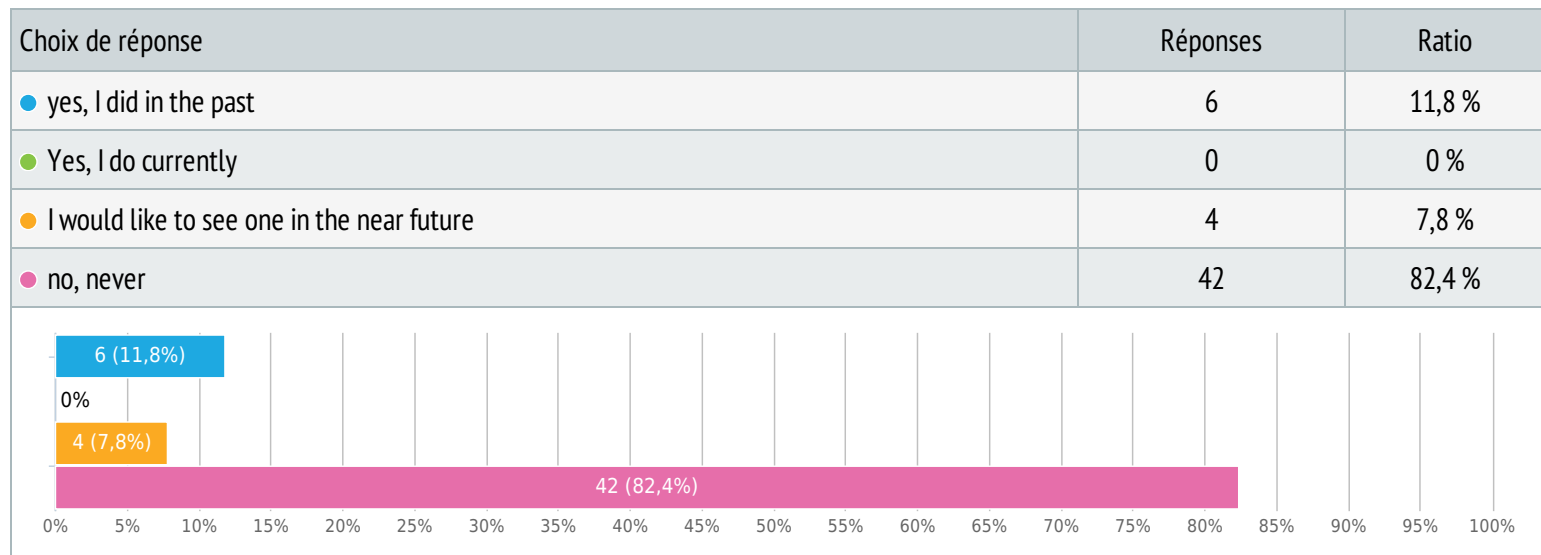

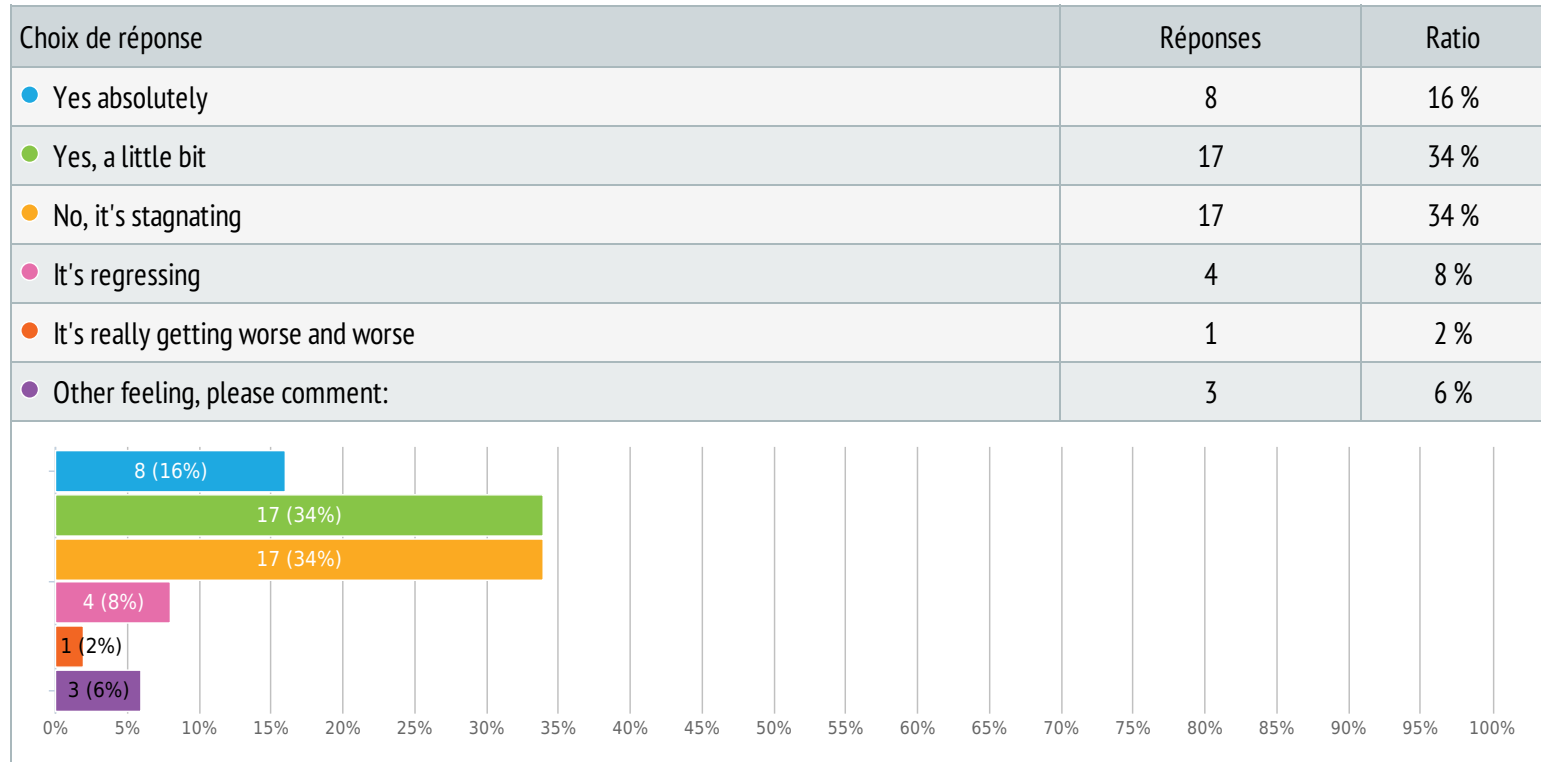

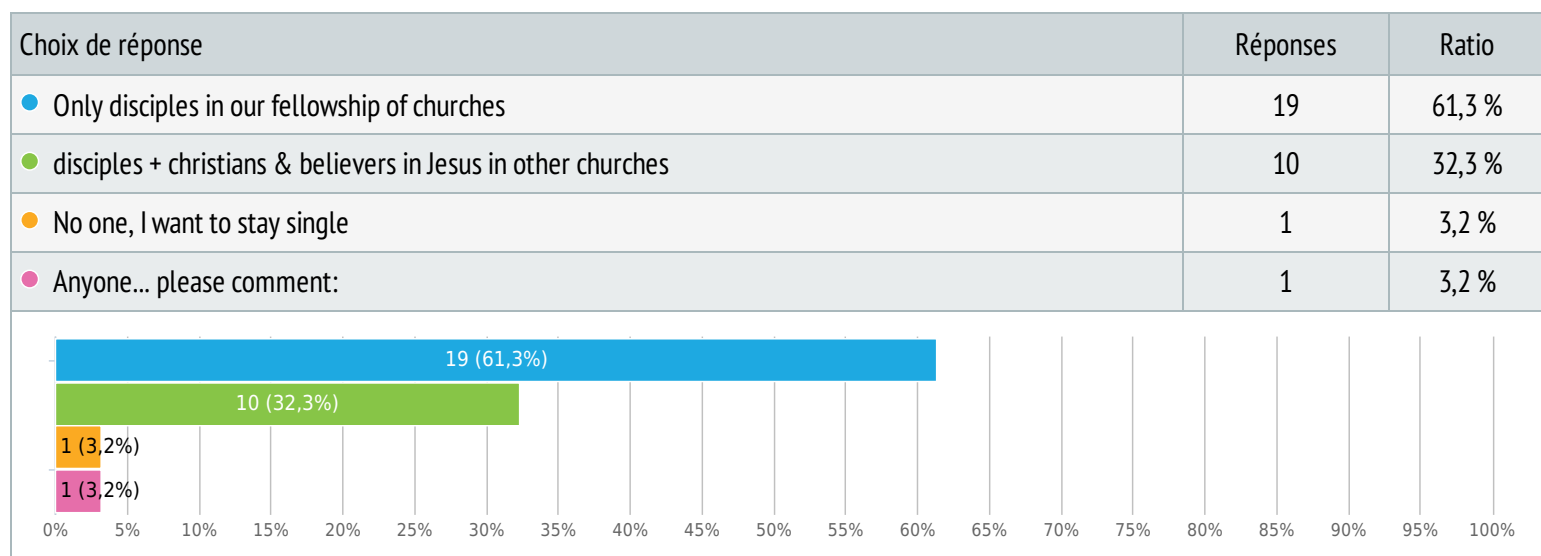

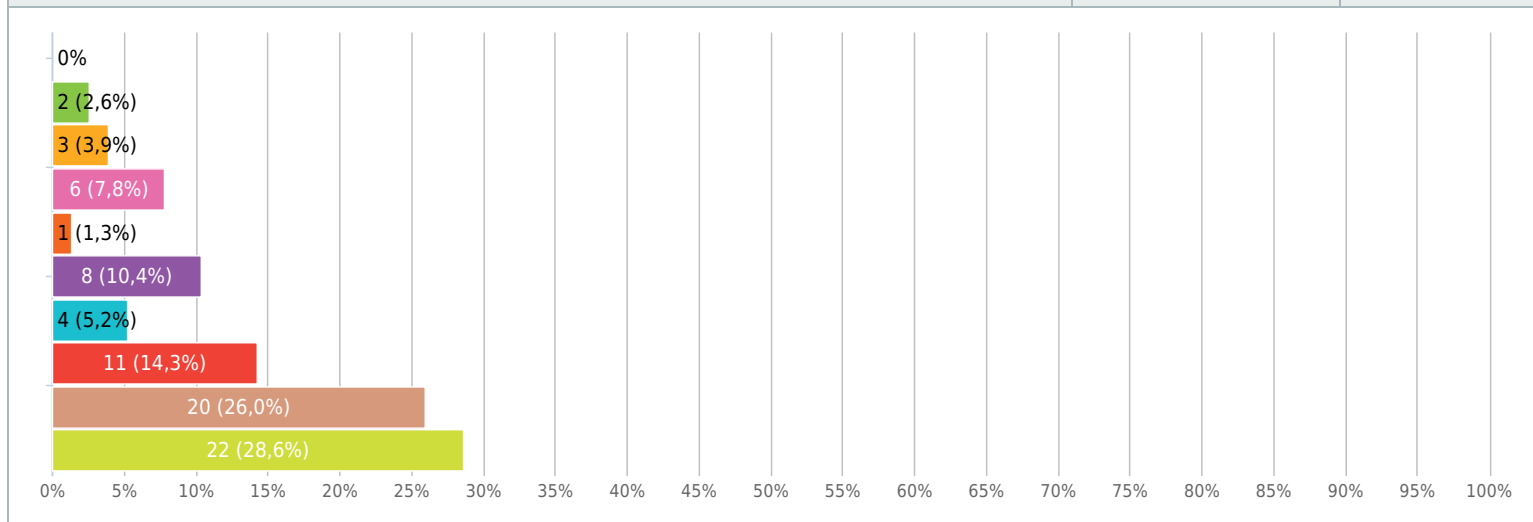

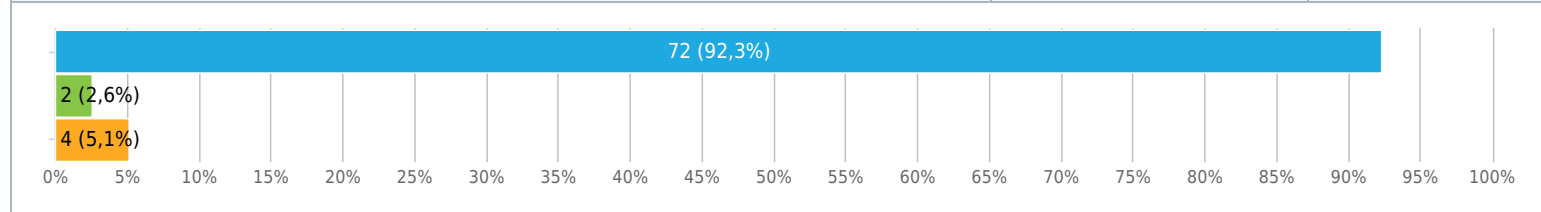

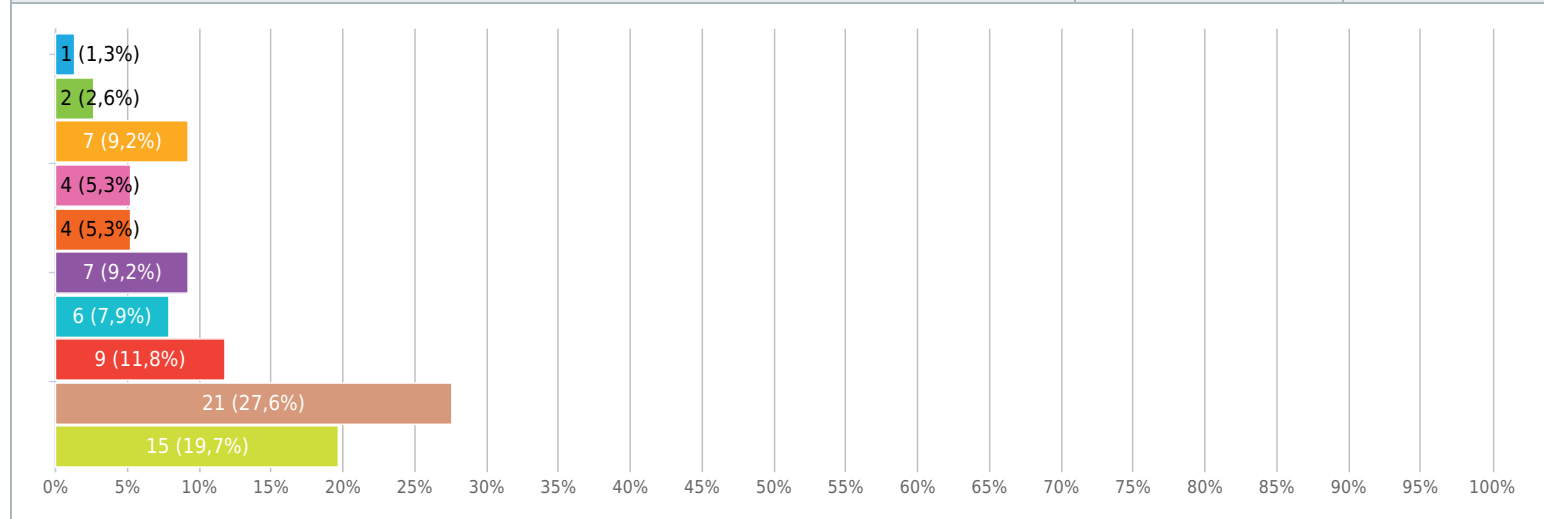

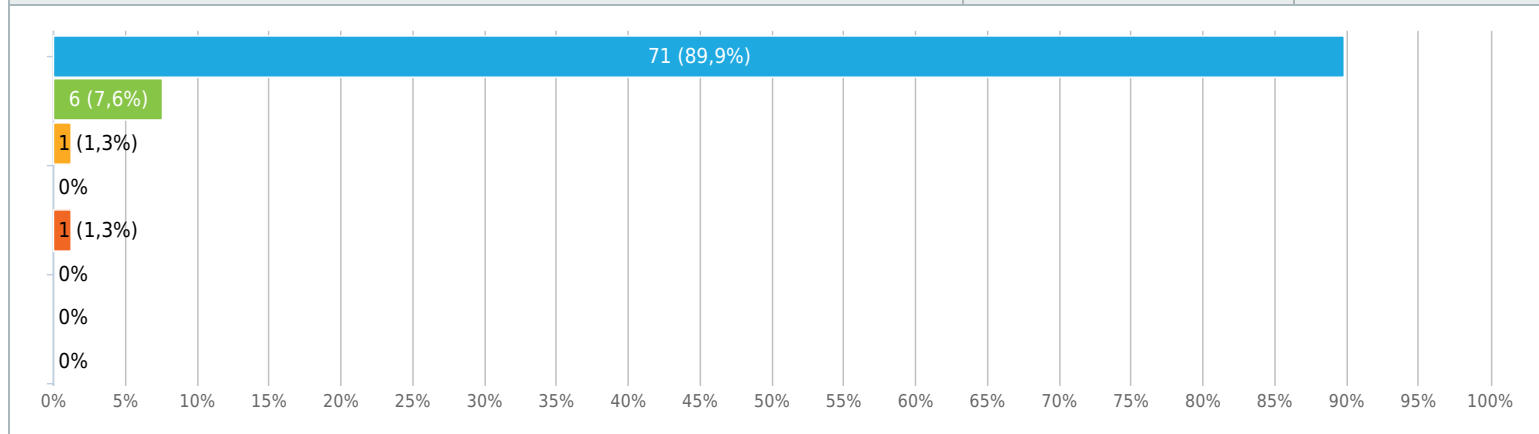

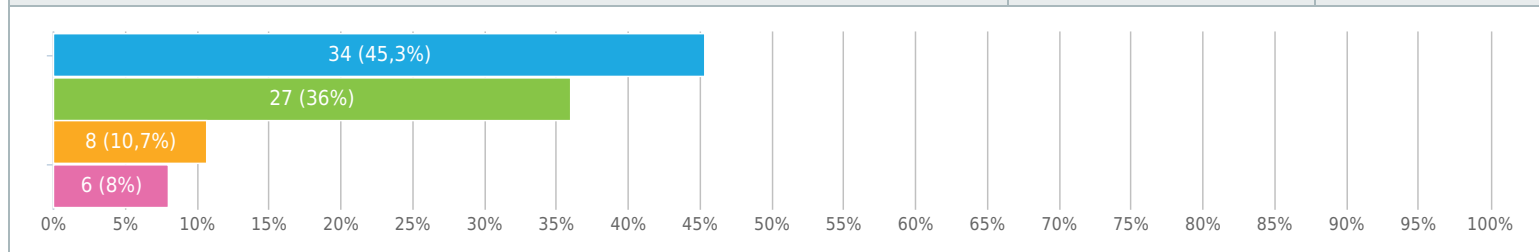

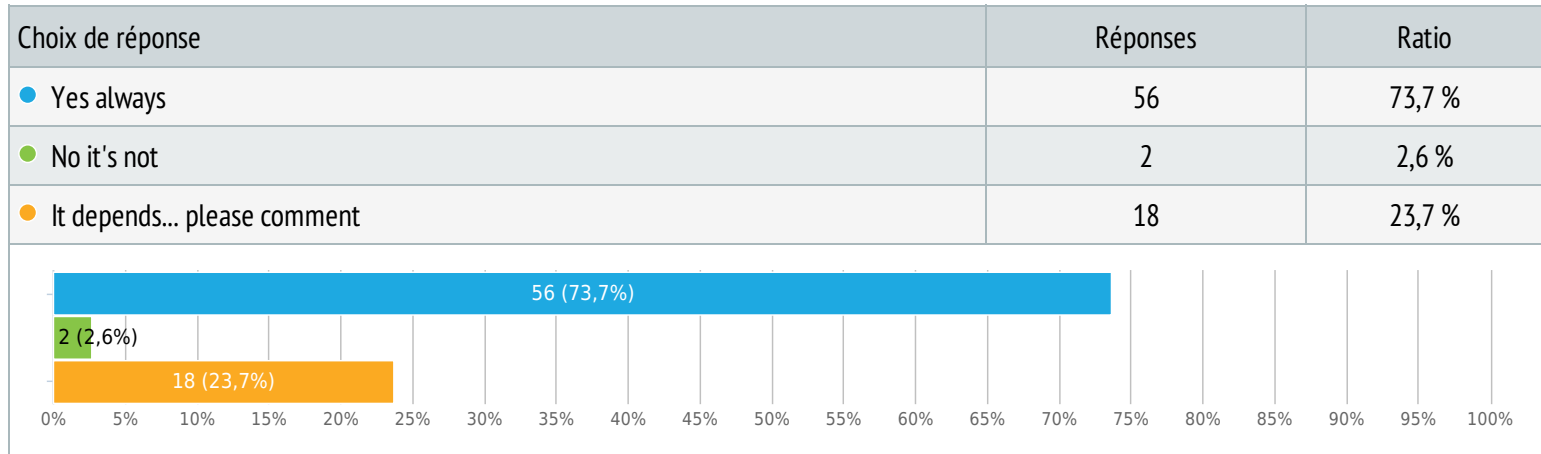

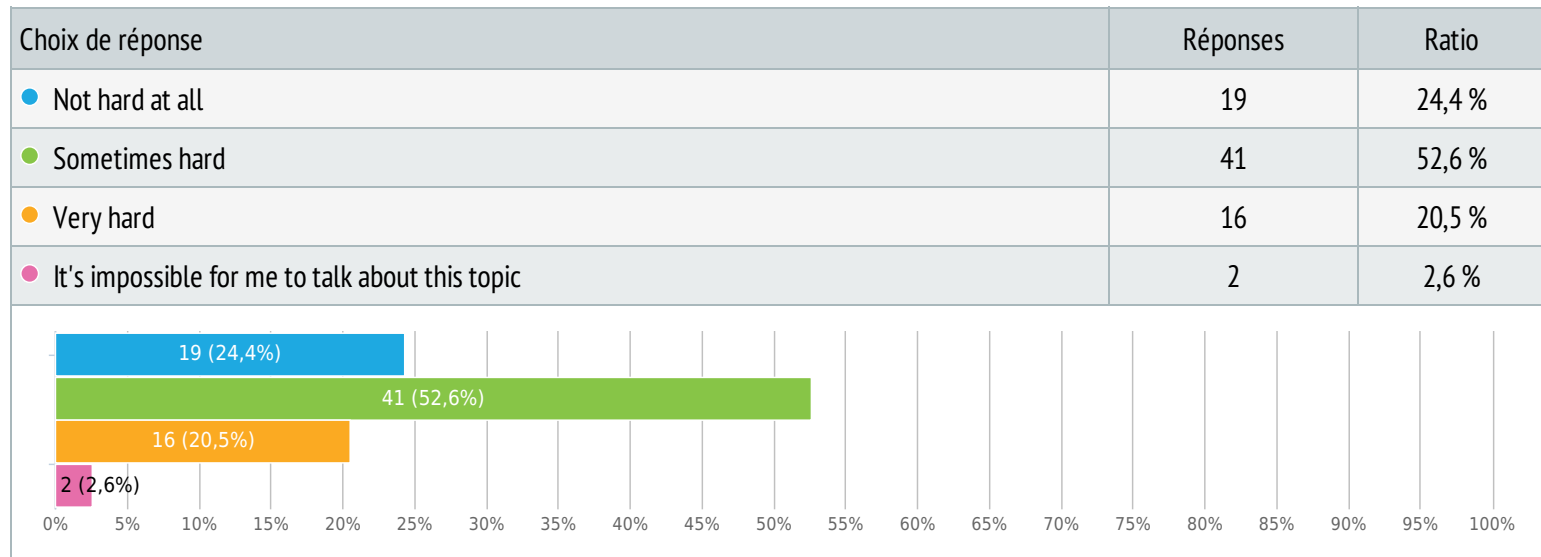

- Homosexuality is a sin but is not possible to homosexual people to change their sexual identity

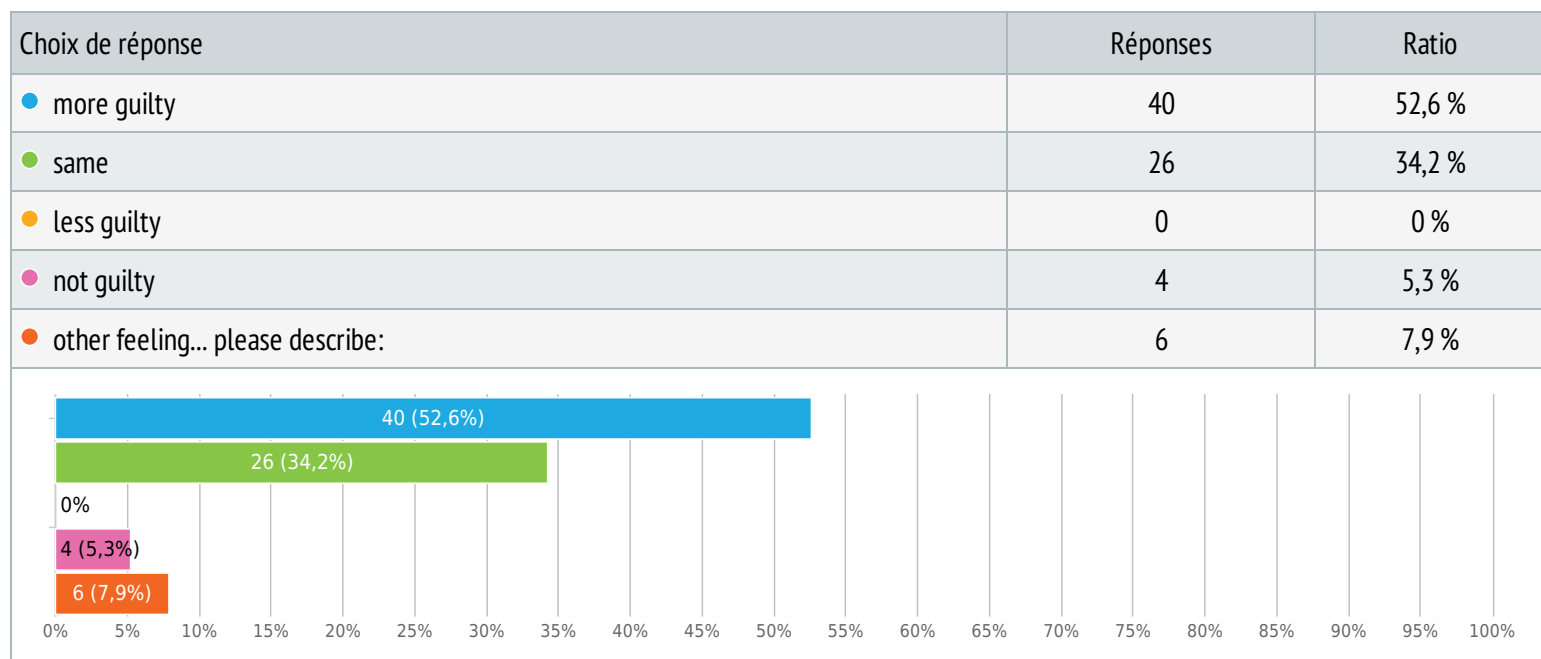
24. Do you find it hard to talk about your sexuality with your friends in the church?

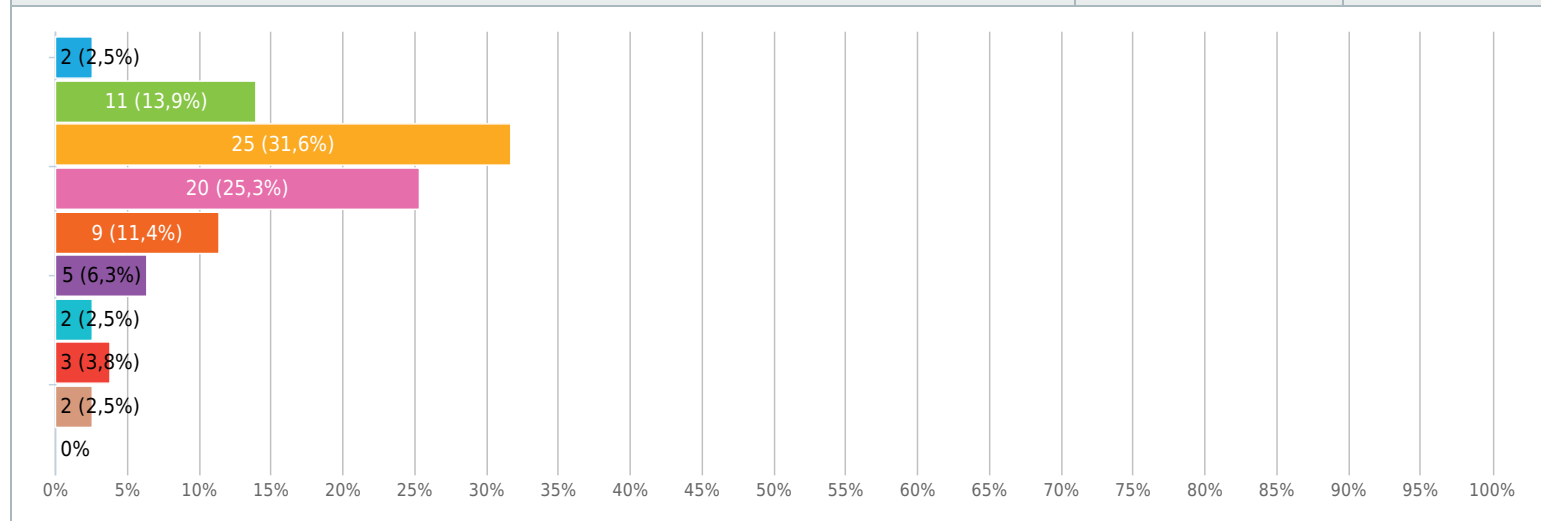
